## SEP 26ENCHANTING UBUD TOUR(B/L)Spend a full day exploring the best of Ubud, Bali's cultural heart, and discover inspiring views,<br/>waterfall, and cheeky wildlife.

The first stop is at **Tegenungan Waterfall**, Tegenungan waterfall, it is one of the most visited waterfalls near Ubud. Tegenungan Waterfall is located around 15 minutes away from the center of Ubud. It is one of Bali's largest waterfalls and more than an impressive sight.

Drive further north to the iconic rice terraces of Tegallalang, where lush green paddies create a stunning patchwork on the side of the hills and take a short walk through the intricately designed terraces. Next visit **Ubud Palace**, the home of the local royal family standing in the heart of the town. Take a walk through the nearby **Ubud Market** among the colorful stalls of wood carvings, textiles and souvenirs.

After lunch, visit **Ubud Monkey Forest**, a sanctuary for the malevolent but photogenic long tail macaques. Walk through the forest and temple were mischievous monkeys roam freely. On the far side of the forest, the car will be waiting to drive you back to the hotel.

craters surrounded by untouched nature. After passing the greenery, leave the vehicle and set off				

Visit a **coffee plantation**, take a walk and see how coffee is produced using natural techniques by local farmers. Munduk is blessed with fertile soil and perfect for coffee and other plantation such us clove. The local farmers here produce coffee from generation to generation and still maintain the traditional process until now. After enjoying a coffee drink, we continued to visit one of the many waterfalls in the area. The trek to **the waterfall** could be exhausting but the reward is worth. Cool off with a dip in the pool or sit on the edge and soak your feet.

Lunch will be served at a local restaurant, and after that return to the hotel.

## **PASSPORT & VISA INFORMATION**

Please ensure that all arranged documentation with the appropriate consulate is done well in advance of their departure from the USA and that passports are valid for the minimum validity required for ALL destinations being travelled to. The information following only applies to the itinerary booked with BC Tours & Travel **PASSPORTS** 

- I. Passports must be valid for a minimum of 6 months from your scheduled return date.
- II. VISAS 10 Maldives: A Visa on Arrival is required. Indonesia: A Visa is on arrival is required. VOA-Visa on Arrival cost remains at IDR 500.000 per person (applies to adults and children). VOA-Visa on Arrival is for a single Entry into Bali/Indonesia, for a stay up to 30 days and can be extended for a maximum 1 time at the local Immigration Office (charges apply)
  Payment can be done by: VISA Card, Master Card or Debit Card Cash in IDR or foreign currency USD, EURO, GBP, SGD and others as per set exchange at the airport counter inside the terminal. E-VOA It is now possible to apply online up to up to 14 days before arrival via the following website: https://molina.imigrasi.go.id/ E-VOA is a single-entry visa which is valid for a stay up to 30 days and can be extended for a maximum 1 time at the local Immigration Office (charges apply) Arriving in possess of the e-visa allows to queue directly for the passport stamping, skipping the line to purchase the VOA- Visa on Arrival.
- III. IMPORTANT NOTE: Starting on 14 February 2024, Bali will implement a new tourist entrance fee of IDR 150,000 or approx. USD 10 per person for foreign visitors, including children. This fee will be charged directly to visitors on arrival, by cash or credit card, and it is in addition to the existing Visa on Arrival (VOA) fee of IDR 500,000. UAE: At this time of quotation, a VISA is not required. This applies to US passport holders only. Please make sure that all destinations to be visited or transited are verified with the applicable consulate(s) for entry requirements prior to departure, together with requirements for anyone travelling on non-USA passports.

## **HEALTH INFORMATION:**
